Transport to the city centre from Dublin International Airport

Taxi: There is a taxi rank outside the arrivals area at Dublin airport. A one way fare to the city centre takes from 30-45 minutes depending on traffic and costs approximately €25-€30. If you require a receipt, you will need to request it from the driver as they do not automatically issue one however they are obliged to provide you with a **printed receipt (not handwritten)** upon request.

Aircoach: Departs from outside the Arrivals Terminal at Dublin airport every 15 minutes from 05:30 to 23:30 daily. Adult fare is approximately €7 one way and €12 return – tickets can be bought in advance via the website. Disembark outside Trinity College for the Trinity City Hotel (3 minute walk).
